The Substance Abuse Block Grant (SABG) is a federal grant funded by the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA). It's available to provide substance use treatment services to uninsured or underinsured adults and youth with substance use challenges.

FUNDING COVERS THE FOLLOWING GROUPS

Pregnant women/teenagers who use drugs by injection

2

Pregnant women/teenagers who use substances

3

Other individuals who use drugs by injection

4

Substance using women/teenagers with dependent children and their families, including women who are attempting to regain custody of their children

5

As funding is available - all other individuals who use substances, regardless of gender or route of use
